Arrow Dynamic Archery - Membership Rules

Welcome to **Arrow Dynamic Archery**! We are excited to have you as part of our archery community. To ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable experience for everyone, we ask that all members, parents, and guardians adhere to the following membership rules.

1. General Membership Rules

- **Eligibility:** Membership is open to all individuals (JOAD and AAP) aged 8 and above. Minors must have a parent or guardian's consent.
- Non-Transferable: Memberships are personal and cannot be transferred to others.
- **Dues:** Membership fees must be paid in full and on time. Failure to make timely payments may result in suspension or termination of membership.
- **Communication:** All members are expected to regularly check their email and/or the club's app for important updates, including schedule changes and event announcements.

2. Code of Conduct for Archers

- **Respect for Others:** Treat fellow archers, coaches, and staff with respect and courtesy at all times. Harassment, bullying, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- **Follow Safety Rules:** Archers must strictly adhere to all safety protocols and range rules provided by Arrow Dynamic Archery staff. Unsafe behavior will result in immediate disciplinary action.
- **Listening to Coaches:** Follow all instructions given by coaches and staff. Archers must wait for the "all-clear" signal before retrieving arrows or moving forward on the range.
- **Equipment Maintenance:** Archers are responsible for maintaining their own equipment and ensuring it is safe to use. If using club equipment, it must be returned in good condition.
- **No Horseplay:** Running, roughhousing, or any type of disruptive behavior on the range is strictly prohibited.
- **Dress Code:** Archers must wear appropriate clothing and safety gear (e.g., armguards, finger tabs) while on the range. Closed-toe shoes are mandatory.
- Attendance and Punctuality: Archers should arrive on time for their scheduled classes or sessions. Repeated tardiness or absences may result in the loss of membership privileges.
- **Good Sportsmanship:** Archers are expected to display good sportsmanship during all classes, practices, and competitions.

3. Code of Conduct for Parents and Guardians

• **Supportive Environment:** Parents and guardians are encouraged to support their child in a positive manner. Criticism, negative comments, or pressuring your child or others during classes and competitions will not be tolerated.

- **Respect for Coaches:** Coaches are certified professionals, and their instructions and decisions should be respected. Please refrain from coaching your child or giving unsolicited advice during sessions.
- **No Interference:** Parents and guardians must stay in designated spectator areas and should not interfere with ongoing classes or range activities. Distractions can compromise safety and the learning environment.
- Prompt Pick-Up and Drop-Off: Ensure your child arrives and is picked up on time for all
 classes and events. If you are unable to pick up your child promptly, please notify us in
 advance.
- **Safety First:** Parents should familiarize themselves with the safety rules of the range and ensure their child understands and follows these rules at all times.
- Clear Communication: If you have any concerns or questions regarding your child's progress or the program, please address them with the coach in a respectful and timely manner, either after class or via email.

4. Safety Rules

- **Strict Safety Protocols:** Safety is our top priority. All archers must follow range rules, including waiting for the coach's signal before shooting and retrieving arrows.
- **No Distractions:** Personal devices, including cell phones, must be silenced or turned off during classes to avoid distractions on the range.
- Proper Equipment Use: Only approved equipment is allowed on the range. If you are
 unsure whether your equipment meets safety standards, please ask a coach for an
 inspection.
- Accidents: In the event of an accident or injury, alert a coach or staff member immediately. First aid supplies are available on-site.

5. Discipline and Penalties

- **Warnings:** Any violation of safety rules, disruptive behavior, or failure to follow the code of conduct will result in a verbal warning.
- **Suspension:** Repeated violations or serious misconduct may result in temporary suspension of membership privileges.
- **Termination:** Serious breaches of safety, bullying, harassment, or other inappropriate behavior will result in immediate termination of membership without a refund.

6. Cancellation and Refund Policy

• **Membership Cancellation:** Members may cancel their membership by providing written notice. Refunds will be issued only under special circumstances, at the discretion of Arrow Dynamic Archery.

• Class Cancellations: If a class is canceled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, members will be notified via email or app, and a make-up session will be arranged if possible.

• By signing the membership form, you agree that Arrow Dynamic Archery may use photos or videos taken during classes or events for promotional purposes unless you have opted out.

8. Range Cleanliness and Etiquette

- **Clean Up After Use:** Archers are responsible for cleaning up their area after practice, including collecting all arrows and trash.
- **Shared Space:** Respect the range, equipment, and fellow archers by keeping the space clean and orderly.
