Arrow Dynamic Archery Range - Safety Rules

1. Always Follow Range Commands

Whether given by a range official or posted signs, always adhere to the range's safety commands and signals. If unsure, ask before proceeding.

2. Keep Your Arrow Pointed Downrange

Arrows must always be pointed toward the target area, even when preparing to shoot. Never aim your bow at people or in any direction other than downrange.

3. Do Not Shoot Without Permission

Always ensure it is safe to shoot before releasing an arrow. If using the range with others, wait until all archers are ready and confirm that the shooting line is clear.

4. Stay Behind the Shooting Line

Archers and spectators must stay behind the designated shooting line unless retrieving arrows. Never step forward while others are still shooting.

5. Nock Arrows Only When on the Shooting Line

Arrows should only be nocked (attached to the bowstring) when you are on the shooting line and ready to shoot. This prevents accidental releases or injuries.

6. Wait for All Clear to Retrieve Arrows

Once all archers have finished shooting, ensure that it's safe before walking downrange to retrieve arrows. Confirm that no one is shooting and that the area is clear.

7. Check Your Equipment Before Shooting

Before each use, inspect your bow, arrows, and other equipment for damage. Never shoot with faulty or damaged gear, as this can lead to accidents or injuries.

8. Wear Appropriate Clothing and Gear

Ensure you are wearing tight-fitting clothing and closed-toe shoes. Loose clothing, jewelry, or accessories can interfere with your shot and may be hazardous.

9. Keep the Range Clear of Hazards

Keep the shooting area free from clutter or obstacles. Equipment should be neatly organized to prevent accidents or distractions.

10. No Running on the Range

Always walk when retrieving arrows or moving around the range. Running can lead to accidents or collisions with other archers.

11. Respect Other Archers

Be considerate of those around you by giving them space and avoiding distractions. Do not disturb other archers while they are shooting.

12. Stay Focused and Alert

Pay attention to your surroundings, equipment, and other archers at all times. Distractions or lack of awareness can lead to unsafe situations.
